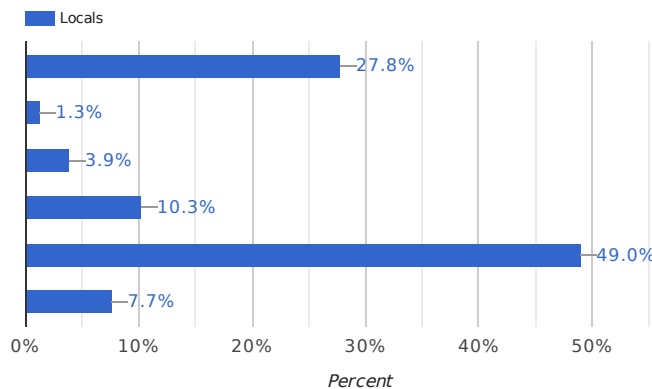

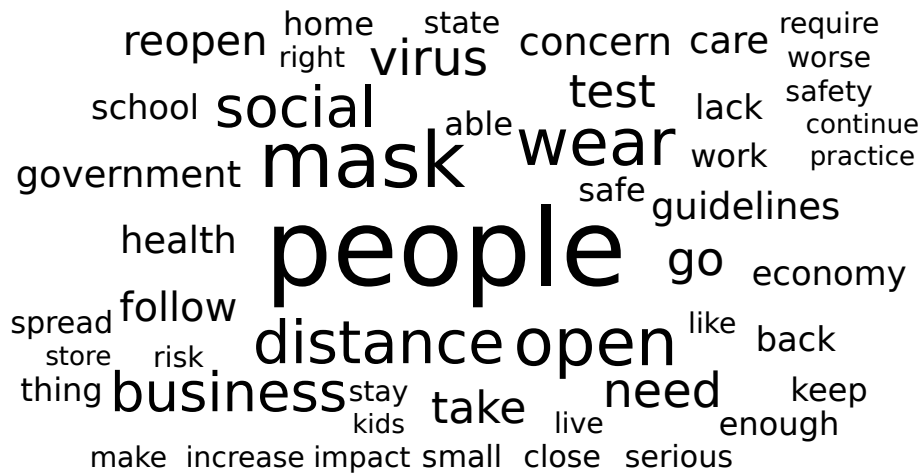

We have done our part and stayed home so we "wouldn't overwhelm the healthcare system" but it's time to allow businesses to reopen.

Very few people respect the distancing, I have to put my hand out and ask them to stop as I am approached. Hand sanitizer is not available, nor are masks and gloves.

All retail, restaurants, wineries/breweries and workplaces should require masks and have hand sanitizer available throughout their locations.

Please have Anti Body testing available. If we had or suspect we had the virus, there is no place to get tested

We must not omit shelter-in-place too soon!!! Worried about summer influx of tourists.

I am at risk. I am concerned my husband will be forced back to work, get exposed, and bring it home.

When the crisis hit, we were told that California would need 50,000 more medical professionals but instead, I have only been working half my shifts since the census on the unit is so low.

I'm also worried about the number of false negatives happening during testing. I think it's important that we understand the rate of spread and that we have a very clear action plan for safely reopening and monitoring the impact. I want to feel my family is safe in the community to go out to places as they reopen, but I'm not seeing clear evidence that our businesses are being properly prepared for the necessary health and safety protocols.

How best do we increase our guest population?

Providing accurate information would help reduce fear. For example, most people with covid have few, if any, symptoms. This means that increased positive tests does not necessarily mean increased hospital load or death.

I think we should be able open some types of businesses now and others soon.

I think traffic will get worse for those who have cars but choose to not use public transportation.

Masks should be mandated not recommended. Too many don't think they need to wear a mask to protect others and are acting irresponsibly

I've heard from many people in the area who seem completely unconcerned with the idea that they could pass this disease onto others, and who think the solution is for vulnerable people to stay home so that they can feel good about going out and not risking vulnerable people. Vulnerable people need essential services, too! In addition, there have been many people who have become seriously ill, some who have died, with no apparent health conditions. It will not be safe to return to normal until we have a vaccine.

We need the dump to open to the public...without the means to do our defensible space, we are creating another MAJOR risk for our area. Additionally, I am concerned that people will start illegal dumping.

Stop restricting freedom. mandatory closures and "stay at home" orders should never happen in this country.

None, except that i believe caution in all manners is our best road map.

More testing needs to be done

We all need to pivot and make our lives have less contact to avoid this in the future. This will be the norm, so we should pressure businesses to rethink their process to protect public health at all times and in the future.

Stop this hiding insanity. You are killing the economy. Burn the village to save the village = no more village. We flattened the curve which is what you wanted. Why keep changing the goals Please, no one is immune. We will all eventually get the virus.

OPEN UP THE DANG COUNTY!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

The COVID-19 virus is serious, my nephew died from it. My mother was a twin in 1918, her twin died at 6 months of age in 1919 due to that pandemic. People do not understand how important it is to stay as safe as possible. With the right

personal safety equipment and health measurements, we can return to a normal life and work places, but we must be diligent in these measures.

My concerns are that the public believes that because the numbers aren't very high in Placer County and that things seem to be leveling off that it is okay to not listen to the Shelter in Placer orders, which will then lead to the outbreak becoming worse as well as if orders are lifted and the county reopens too quickly.

I'm very worried about the anger and hostility toward out-of-towners. I've lived part time in Tahoe for 7 years, but I left when SIP was ordered. In speaking with my friends who are there they say their anger towards out-of-towners is the highest they've ever seen it. I sincerely hope it is not as bad as I am hearing.

I recognize it's such a delicate balancing act between health and safety/people's lives and the devastation to the economy, as well as our freedom as individuals to make our own choices. That balance can only be achieved with much research, care, honesty and communication.

This has affected my health by not being able to see my doctor

Get businesses and employment open. Requires masks for now. Provide hand sanitizing stations everywhere!

Open up the economy! We are dying economically and I know CA and local government officials need not worry about that but we do. If we do not open the economy within a few weeks we will pack up and move to Texas. For good! We are already planning the logistics of the move. This is a California government caused crisis and the government suffers no consequences. None! How can it be that 'we are in this together' and the government staff continues to get paychecks? This is messed up and we are out of California!

I think the step by step process presented by the governor makes sense.

I think that service providers (nail salons, hair stylists) should be required to wear masks while providing services.

Before anyone goes out, they ought to be tested unless they have self-quarantined for at least 14 days.

Slow and steady. Let other areas make the mistake of opening too fast.

Remind people that wearing or not wearing a mask is not a political statement.

More community education about what 'flattening the curve' actually means, and what it's designed to accomplish. Absent a vaccine, the total number of cases remains the same as with no interventions, but they're spread out over time so as not to exceed our healthcare system's capacity.

Look, people have been told what to do and haven't. When we open, those very people will continue. This has been very frustrating for all and I for one am tired of the lack of respect. We have first line responders taking extraordinary risks and I am frustrated with some of the responses. In the end, this will not change. Hoping Quarry Park Adventures can open soon since it's open air. If they require and/or offer gloves and masks it seems like it would be something to open earlier than most other entertainment options.

Slow and easy is the only way to go.

Short term rentals in East Placer MUST remain closed.

The worst thing in the world we could do is to ease the restrictions too early. Another round of infections is already being predicted. We need to stay at home and if we do go out we should social distance and wear masks! And, those restrictions should be enforced by the Auburn Police Department!

All public retail, dining and workplaces must have automatic opening doors. Restrooms must have tissue paper at the entrance and exit or automatic doors.

Crowded access to retail businesses should be avoided (limit numbers of customers. Install cashier protection shields. Provide ability to remotely determine outside line lengths.

In the last question, you put hair/nails in the same "personal care" category as doctors/dentists. In my mind, those are two very different types of service providers. I'd go -- and have gone -- to the doctor without a mask multiple times since this started. I would not go even with a mask to a nail salon right now.

We need to reopen. Herd immunity needs to take place. The idea of SIP was to flatten the curve so our medical facilities would not be overwhelmed. We knew there would still be some deaths but at least our hospitals would be able to care for those who needed it. Our economy is dying

There isn't any way to get back to normal from here, but keep calm and stay kind.

I've had to go to the grocery store, and I can tell you that if COVID is more lethal or transmittable than a typical flu, we should expect a lot of additional deaths. Our neighbors are either too impatient, stubborn, or ignorant to follow proper protocols. That's the irony about those who want to open immediately. Had they been willing to comply with guidance given regarding masks and social distancing, we probably would be back open already, but they're precisely the people who ignore all the guidance.

I'm in the highest risk group and walk or bike to Folsom Lake via the Douglas Blvd each day. There are always large groups of young people there not practicing social distancing or wearing masks. Park rangers and the Sheriffs drive by and say nothing. Even on trails, I have to run off trail out of the way, because groups come straight at me with no regard to the risk pose to me and other older visitors. I was young once and I get it. We've all been cooped up too long and have cabin fever, but nobody seems to be taking the public health guidelines seriously and it's frustrating and dangerous.

Lets get on with it

I'm fortunate enough to be retired and have adequate resources to get through the stay-at-home period. I'm concerned about some of my neighbors who are eager to get out & about again, and who don't seem to realize the scientific reasoning behind quarantine measures. I don't want to be put at risk by their ignorance and/or stubbornness ... but I will be.

Open now

Can we please have our freedom back and get Placer County open?

Do not open too soon. We are less than half way thru this pandemic!

There will be many deaths due to unintended consequences caused by the lockup and collapsing finances for many: Loss of wages, business, home, suicide by some, drug and alcohol relapses, spousal and child violence, heart attack, stroke and other mental and physical diseases due to financial and lock up stress -

A family member is in a high risk group and has been advised by her doctor to socially distance well before the stay-at-home order was in place. As this will continue after the stay is lifted, nothing will change for us/our family. I do believe it is important for people to be able to do outside activities but masks should be required for ALL indoor social situations. We are also concerned about schooling as we will be unable to send our kids back so distance learning will need to continue for our family. High risk and sick people stay home. The rest go back to work or work from home if possible. re-open schools. I would really like to know how Newsom came up with his 56% "attack" rate which he used as the reason for lockdown. That is a very unsubstantiated percentage.

I think Dr. Aimee Sisson and team are doing a great job and I wish people, including our elected officials, had greater appreciation for her work

why hasn't PC enforced those "non-essential" businesses that are open during this time??? Like Barber hps & Salons that are advertised in the A-J??

As we transition, I think we will need clear direction (with date issued easily found) on our risks and expectations. I'm concerned that I will not feel comfortable going out as so many other members of the public speak as though their actions are not going to affect anyone else and that they will not be cautious as we reopen. At this point, I plan to still order items for pickup and delivery when possible so I can limit my contact with others. I am also concerned that employers may not be amenable to allowing vulnerable persons to remain at home.

Peoples Lives are more important than money... opening too fast puts people at risk all for the sake of money, and not for saving lives. It is sad our Federal Government and many other local governments put money and the economy ahead of lives.

If businesses could make a plan on how to serve customers observing social distance - and in some cases with masks (like salons) then I think we should get to it! Gyms can have online sign up sheets to keep social distance in place.

This should have happened weeks ago! This experiment was a failure on multiple levels. The County Health Officer and the Governor only considered one symptom and not the body as a whole. Where was the voice for our livelihoods? In the future there has to be a balanced solution that does not destroy the economy. Our numbers are so low; we aren't among the areas that need to continue such drastic measures. If the infection and/or death rate jumps appreciably, we can enact new measures to mitigate.

If done too fast, infections will spike and then getting people back under a shelter order will be next to impossible. The county really needs to step and lead through this challenging time.

Please don't forget about the Dog Parks, our pets are getting depressed too!

Contact tracing needs to be in place. A data point or R value needs to be well communicated to the public because when the rate of infection returns and rises people need to know why they will need to return to quarantine.

I would feel more comfortable if I believed that the majority of people would wear a mask (which I don't). I think people are pushing to open much too soon.

I think the Placer county doctor Aimee has done a great job dealing with this situation. She was realistic, smart, and didn't make false promises about modeling results and SIP deadlines.

Most pressing concern is opening up too many places, too quickly. Would like to see a plan for gradual re-opening. Secondary concern are the people that feel their rights are being infringed upon. I envision many people 'not following a plan' out of spite, ignorance, etc. Before transitioning I feel it is imperative to have testing available for everyone (the immediate test, not the one that takes 2-10 days to get results)

I question what, if anything, has changed to the point that we can now go out? If there's still no vaccine, we could still contract the virus?

My confidence would be much higher if both forms of testing (current infection and past infection) were available on demand

Go slowly!

I just want my freedom back. I won't wear a mask. I'll respect 6ft distance for the sheep in public. If I feel sick or have a cough I'll stay at home. I want business back open so people can work and feed their families and pay bills. Give us our freedom back. I moved from Sacramento County to Placer County so I could be free. Now it's time for our freedom to come back.

Some people are far more careful than others, so there is little consistency meeting people. Attitudes range from "it's a hoax" to "I'll never get it" to "I probably already had it" to "it will kill me." So in the grocery store, some people keep their distance with their masks on, while some breeze by with no mask. Seems that everyone should continue to be cautious, which seems the wisest approach.

I believe that the governor has over reacted to the situation and has mishandled it badly. With precautions, we need to start opening up NOW!

Please support businesses with PPE, this is expensive and they are already struggling. Please open lodging and rentals soon in North Lake Tahoe. Lodging properties have a great opportunity to educate their customers on the current state of Placer COVID-19 reopening. I would much rather have guests that are paying for lodging, and therefore, TOT, than day trippers that aren't contributing to the economy. Also curious how daytrippers are going to the bathroom and disposing of trash with things closed? Maybe there is a way to further discourage daytrippers, and incentive over night trips.

The community needs clarity about intended timelines to re-open (specifically as it pertains to short term rental / lodging accommodations). In order to re-stimulate the economy up here, the tourism sector needs to be able to move with some degree of confidence that business will be open.

Sadly I suspect that we will have to divide people up, those with lower risk and those with higher risk and develop restrictions and solutions for each - Then enforce. We will have to assist those high risk individuals who will have trouble because they live with others who are low risk. Supply PPEs and training etc. But at some point soon we will have to allow those with low risk of prolonged illness or death to move forward with their productive lives.

Slow and steady wins the race. It would be worse to open up too much, too soon and end up having to close everything done again due to increased infections.

Unless there is a discernible reason to wait much longer, let's get this re-opening done SOON and confront the consequences with empirical evidence in hand.

We need to have supplies go back to normal, i.e. toilet paper, sanitation wipes. I hope to see limits set on these items until things are completely back to normal. The stores are always out of toilet paper, where is it going?

Don't rush it.

Let us get back to work and healthy activities

It's time to get back out there and be good about washing hands and sanitizing.

My family is probably not the norm with this virus - we are all still working or thankfully getting full pay while working from home so not really any hardships

I'd like to see wide spread testing available for all

Open!!! Especially Topgolf. They can have safety measures as easily as Golfland. Maybe just fill every other bay.

Opening must be based upon improved testing, follow-ups and science facts

We need to put mental health and the wellbeing of our children's mental health as high of a priority as this virus. Having teens committing suicide and children numbing out on tablets all summer is going to have a large impact. People think children are resilient and it's not fair to expect that of them. Let them swim with less people than before since the virus doesn't live in maintained pools, let them play at the parks and play tennis. Let them have some sort of normalcy in their lives and stop putting them on the back burner. Bored teens can go two ways: destructive and wreck less or numb and depressed. They need outlets and their social life and outlets are their world in their minds.

I wish all stores would require shoppers to wear masks and keep social distancing.

People need to go to work. Worried about people coming from Bay Area and Sac County - they were already driving up here to get TP in March when they couldn't find it in Bay Area.

I hope stores/hair places open with rules....number of people allowed, one door in and out...continue to sanitize grocery carts (Bel Air)...sanity needs to rule

Business requires customers, so no matter what you do, the public will have to feel better about going to those businesses. Release low walk-in type businesses as soon as possible.

I wish there was a way to open the community and let residents feel comfortable without a rush of visitors coming in right away (realize this is a very difficult balancing act)

Covid tests not being available locally with quick results

Do it now! Small businesses are suffering!!

Do it slowly. Be ready to clamp down again if needed.

It's all about the testing and contact tracing

Increased and accurate testing. More frequent briefings by Dr. Sisson with some explanation of data and trends.

Allow small businesses to establish their distancing needs and allow them to open within the next week.

More testing and decreasing infection and death rates are needed

Tension is building so please provide some relief from the restrictions with guidelines.

After a 10-day period of very low new case counts, we have had 17 new cases in the last 5 days in Placer County. I have noticed in recent days that most businesses along the Douglas Blvd corridor are open and parking lots are full. I see very few people wearing masks. I think a massive "re-opening" will have unfortunate results and Placer residents and healthcare workers will be needlessly infected. I will remain indoors or safely separated and masked until case counts sustain very low numbers for 2 weeks. I urge caution in a decision to re-open.

Open everything. Let people take care of themselves.

I don't want to see a second spike of deaths, hospitalizations, in California.

I think opening slowly is most prudent and safe for all.

I would like to see a plan for what happens if we open back up and the virus gets worse. Will we close back up again? I think we have to prioritize health over the economy, but I understand that's hard for lots of people. If we reopen and then have to close, what's the plan for handling people who resist this?

Mask use is idiotic! Public, obviously, does not understand. I see so many older folks out walking, by themselves, wearing a mask, utterly unnecessary.

I sincerely hope it is done with the health of the county in place and not because someone wants to be reelected

People are not listening to the health care officials

Don't see how a customer could go to a restaurant and eat with a mask on.

People are already going about without a mask. If we reopen, we will create a new pandemic by our actions (or inactions).

Shift the strategy to protecting the vulnerable - create barriers, physical and/or procedural, that shield them but allow the rest to care/provide for them. The rest who are not as vulnerable should be allowed to choose whether they accept the risk to go out. Open up businesses with precautions - occupancy limits, mask requirements, provision of hand sanitizer at entry/exit, etc. Extend economic protections to opening businesses (and their employees) that cannot open up completely (e.g., restaurants forced to limit capacity may not sustain their business model without help).

Staying at home has nothing to do with reducing deaths. It is to slow transmission and not overwhelm the hospitals. Ultimately, the same amount of people will contract the virus and the same number will die from the virus. All we are doing is slowing it. So naturally people will still contract it once we re-open but our hospitals haven't been overwhelmed nor do I think they will when we re-open and the virus needs to run its course. We love having one spouse work from home. This could continue if reduced building capacity continued so we would like to see that.

For our family, churches are one of the biggest priority. In our faith, even if only with social distancing, getting together for corporate worship is one of the most important things we do with our time.

This is killing small businesses while allowing big box stores to remain open! People with compromised systems need to be responsible for their safety by self isolating & we need to be trusted as citizens to be mindful of them without our liberties being stripped away.

I am 70, female, live with husband and daughter. I have lung disease and am on an immunosuppressant. I am retired. Our retirement funds took a big hit. If I become sick, disabled, or die because of virus so be it. Younger people need to get back to work and save their businesses. People need the sacraments; souls are at stake.

There are many ways to lose lives and we can't protect against all of them. People losing their loved ones is tragic but losing their livelihoods is tragic also. Hopefully we have learned to be wary and careful. How will we know when the right time is for certain? Trying is the only way and it is time to try living our lives again. With wisdom and caution.

People are not following directives now, so what is to say they will follow any new regulations for opening up.

I live on the West Shore and can not express enough how concerned my neighbors and I are about a large influx of visitors/short-term renters. I feel that our community has done a great job of SIP and with a large reopening that allows for tourists we could easily slide backwards, particularly because visitors/renters tend to come in groups. That means groups in the grocery stores (which I don't believe are yet equipped), groups on the bike paths, groups walking our neighborhoods, etc.

Concerned by impact to local employment, economy and housing prices

I think it is important to open any businesses that can be safely operated during the pandemic. In order for that to happen safest, masks should be mandatory to stop the possible asymptomatic spread of the virus. Any activity that cannot safely be done while wearing masks (or in the case of kids, not common play areas) should not be done.

For the health of the people and the economy we must lift these illegal orders which are stifling our robust economy. The information available to everyone shows that the threat of the virus is zero on healthy members of the population and the shut down was ill advised. End it now!

Don't go too fast. The worse thing that could happen is we are not careful and all hell breaks loose

I hope there will continue to be limitations on visitors/tourists to the area until supplies have become readily available and treatment options become available for Covid 19. If visitors are not limited the curve would not end.

Go slow, listen to science

As a vulnerable person, I don't think I'll be going out for a very long time. Asymptomatic transmission is very worrisome. I'd love nothing more than to go to a grocery store, get my hair done or get together with family and friends. However, so many people haven't followed rules to date! People will be even more relaxed as things reopen. Our neighbors had a number of families over with children playing together and no social distancing at all! I've tried to go for walks in Maidu and too many people make no effort to social distance or be considerate of others. Recently at curbside pickup the clerk came far too close and I was forced to take their pen and clipboard to sign for my purchase made online. Some items are not available for delivery or curbside pickup at all (toilet paper). Efforts should be made to make delivery or pickup of such items. available to seniors and vulnerable people. Senior hours are far too early in the morning and lines are too long.

People are not used to sacrificing and need good role models. This affects all of us. We need to do what is good for all of us.

Those more vulnerable ie, over 65, immune deficiencies, etc, should be protected with shopping hours, enforcement of everyone wearing masks until further notice. I go out for necessities about once a week and at least half of the public are not wearing masks as well as their children, who can be vectors. I'm afraid too many people are not taking this virus seriously enough.

We are a family of 8. I don't work. My husband works and hasn't been able to. We are struggling.

There has been too much media hype without sound facts. This has turned into a political pandemic and our Governor's are trying to push a top-down management approach when in fact this should be managed from the bottom up at the local level. Proper risk management with targeted mitigation strategies need to be owned at the lowest level. One-size fits all approach from the top down makes no sense. Rural areas have very low risk compared to urban high-density population areas. The risks are not the same. When you understand how the virus survives, closing beaches makes no sense at all. Perform risk management at the lowest level and mitigate only those risks that can be impacted.

STORES ( INCLUDING GROCERY) SHOULD REQUIRE EVERYONE TO WEAR A MASK OR I WON'T GO IN

Many of the questions don't give a full picture. Would I be comfortable going to a part w/o a mask? Sure, if I'm there with just my family. But, would I go to the park for a soccer game around other people w/o a mask? Nope, probably not even with a mask. If there were MANDATORY restriction WITH ENFORCEMENT that EVERYONE had to wear a mask and stay at least 6 ft apart, it may not be horrible. But, I know that people would not accept that and I know that authorities wouldn't enforce it. It seems that the loudest voices get heard and typically, around here, they are the ones that believe \$\$ is more important than people.

This survey seems very skewed toward a pre-determined decision to willingly put people's lives in danger. We should not open until every local hospital and medical clinic are capable of seeing normal patients, assessing for COVID19, giving a test, processing the results, and initiating a process to trace all contacts associated with people who test positive.

I am elderly with a frail husband. I hope that, for grocery and other retail shopping, special hours for the more vulnerable (elderly and compromised) will continue along with 6 ft spacing in lines, required masks, protective gear for employees and controlled customer numbers.

I would like to see it considered that patrons of local businesses be required to show some sort of proof of residency to enter that business in order to deter those from outside areas from traveling to our area unnecessarily. At least for the initial reopening phase.

It's time to open our world and economy back up people are cautious now they wash your hands they keep safe distance is it's time for this to be over

I know that everyone is anxious to be out and about again, and I'm very aware of the economic impact that this shutdown has had on so many, especially small business owners. I just want re-opening to happen in a careful, considered way to minimize the spread of the virus. I would also like to see regulations enforced in businesses - not just a free-for-all. As it is now, I am MUCH MORE LIKELY to patronize businesses that ensure social distancing among patrons and employees and where the staff and customers wear masks and take precautions.

I do not like the idea of mandatory masks, I feel if someone is concerned they can wear a mask or they can stay home. Distancing is fine.

This stay at home order is hurting our economy and our health care system is well placed to care for people. Start easing restrictions by county rather than by the whole state.

So far the governor appears to be using science and proceeding carefully. I want that to be continued

I am recovering from lymphoma and chemo treatments. I am a huge target to get Covid-19. I am worried when I hear of people wanting to reopen too soon. For me, it's personal!

Just because we are lucky enough to live in a place that is not as populous/dense as the high-risk areas; we should not take this lightly. The business should accept a "new normal" version of operations - ones that will continue to limit the gathering of people and adopt heightened attention to cleaning. Popular trails, such as hidden falls, should take reservations. Private services businesses should have limited appointments and mandates for masks and cleaning precautions.

I understand the concerns about the economy, but we all should support a carefully planned reopening instead of succumbing to political pressure.

Be very clear that there are not fines for people who choose not to do social distancing. Businesses are not liable for anyone contracting any illness.

Even if our Governor does not open up fully, Placer County needs to start with other services business as well that can support re-opening their business. Car detail shops, small retail stores, etc. We can shop at Costco where there are dozens of people at a time touching everything but not a small store where there would only be 2-5 people in there at all. It just does not make sense.

More testing for everybody symptomatic or not some people have it that don't even know it

Lets do this

Prefer to start opening at somewhat a measurable level(if that can be done) and be able to adjust accordingly to the number of infections being reported. How is returning to school going to be regulated or started, and in what fashion?

Start now!

Lets all get Covid and get it over with.

Keep encouraging masks and cleaning procedures. We're all in this together.

While our income isn't affected, I am VERY concerned for all of my small business owner friends in the area. I've tried to support them all as best as possible in the meantime, but am very eager for the day they can continue to earn their livelihood!!!

First, I think that it is important to be self-aware and to wash your hands and face on a regular basis. Secondly, Avoid close contact with anyone that you don't know well and keep up 6 feet social distancing or further from anyone that behaves in any fashion that indicates they are not in peak health. Being careful is the most important thing you can do for your health and well being regardless of a pandemic situation or someday when we are able to behave more normally around each other.

Consistency in messaging is very important.

Will businesses re-hire their former employees - will that be a rule? How will people know if a business is cleaned often and maintained well?

Start with opening state park to camping and boating

I think the longer we are required to stay at home, the harder it will be to feel comfortable out in public and around people. I think socialization is extremely important to our mental well being and we need to get back to our normal way of life. I also think it's important to protect our local community first and think about visitors second. And I think it's important for business to make it easier for customers to not have to touch things that are touched by many (ie: the pin pads on credit card machines and ATMS, door handles (being able to push it with your foot or having automatic doors), having hand sanitizing stations next to places we must touch.

My biggest concern about lifting some of the restrictions is that there will be an influx of visitors. I think we would have to open things up first on a limited basis and then start to open up the hotels/short term rentals. Even before this I think there was a need to regulate short term rentals and now it seems even more pertinent to put some regulations in place.

We need to prioritize safety and health over return to economic activity.

I agree with abiding by State guidelines and waiting, while the two test centers (one in Roseville) open next week, so that we can move forward with a better understanding of the local population's exposure to, and contracting the virus, under varying conditions, and with varying severity. We can wait. We can change for the better, especially if we do not pretend "business as usual" is the magic bullet (which, if one reads the "real" news, understands that this will likely grow worse in the next couple months, given all the foolish rebellion).

Please mandate wearing mask

I'm concerned that my constitutional rights are being infringed upon with this stay-at-home order. I think it's important to open up businesses as soon as possible, leave it up to the discretion of businesses to implement safety measures as they see fit.

All businesses should be allowed to reopen. We can require social distancing, masks or lines where necessary. If Target can remain open for full business, others should be allowed to open. Only a small part of Target is groceries and they are not restricting what you buy, requiring masks or distance. The only thing they don't do is returns...doesn't make any sense.

As a dental hygienist I have deep concerns about myself going back to work. I think most professions can do so without many modifications, unless the patron is face to face with the retailer, barber, etc. In dentistry there are many variables that are almost impossible to implement to protect the staff and the patients. We cannot have patients wear a mask during our procedures. We sit face up face for up to an hour at a time. We will have to wear respiratory protection for most of the day and that cannot be good for us on an ongoing basis. We cannot do our work without producing aerosols, which can linger for three hours or more, placing us and patients at high risk. We will likely come into contact with asymptomatic patients and spread the virus to others and our families. I can go on and on. I would like to be one of the last occupations to open up so we know that covid is going away, and we will learn more about transmission of the disease as more time passes.

I think the counties with very low numbers should open up if they are ready. There are many that have fewer than 100 cases and should be allowed to open. Placer should open gently. But honestly, I think my one chair hair salon should be able to open.

Look, the gist is we can't be too cautious if a second wave is impending. We don't need another Spanish Flu where the 2nd wave was even worse than the first. I'd rather be inconvenienced now, than sorry later.

People have been abusing the distancing orders. I see it every day.

personal use in and out of our homes.

We need to be mindful of the statistics and pull back at any significant sign of increase in the number of COVID 19 patients in the area.

The county needs to better educate us on how the Virus is spread asymptotically

My worry is that we will move too quickly and cause a second spike. Also, I would like to see more accountability for businesses and persons who violate the rules. Those two salons in Auburn that opened, what became of them? How are people able to park near Horseshoe Bar and congregate on the lake? If we are going to have rules, and if they are needed, then we should be adequately enforcing them. Right now it looks like people are able to put others at risk with impunity.

Open State Parks to Camping and Boating

Adding COVID19 safety and sanitation protocols is something we are happy to do for our clients and coworkers. We will recommend to our clients that are in the high risk group to wait for services until they feel safe.

I'm greatly concerned that there has been a lack of enforcement of the shelter in place order in Placer County as it pertains to non essential travel by visitors to Tahoe thus far, and that if restrictions are lifted, too many people will come to Tahoe and create an unnecessary risk of exposure to everyone. Unless local government agencies, including law enforcement, firmly state and enforce restrictions, we will be overrun this summer and be forced to shut down again. As of last week, the Placer County Sheriff's department posted on their Facebook page that they believed businesses should be allowed to open, despite the lack of testing and other mitigation efforts, and that our local economy shouldn't suffer due to reliance upon hypotheticals. This signifies that a major government agency is questioning the science that all of our restrictions are based upon. All tolled, I don't have much faith in local government to protect our community as restrictions are eased.

I think Placer County has relatively few COVID cases and plenty of hospital space if needed. I think the county should reopen carefully. Small businesses that are not too crowded anyway should reopen first. Get people back to work where there is not much danger of spreading the virus.

The long-term economic, social, and psychological costs of the lockdown have not been adequately assessed, and are likely markedly greater than most understand. When this is considered against the fact that the mortality rate of COVID-19 is orders of magnitude lower than originally modeled, the rational decision is to promptly re-open society, empowering citizens to make wise personal decisions about social distancing. We were told we needed to go into lockdown to flatten the curve and not overwhelm our medical system. We were told if we didn't, people would be dying in waiting rooms waiting for medical care. The curve never exploded upward; the models were markedly off and the medical system was not

overwhelmed in our state; not at all. We made decisions that seemed reasonable at the time, but were based on wildly overestimated mortality figures. Now that we have more data, the responsible thing to do is open society back up and leave fear-driven and irrational decisions behind.

People's health is the first concern. Better to keep the social distancing and mask requirement until we are safe. Businesses should transition to a way to provide their service within these parameters. Some cannot do this easily (barbershops, salons, etc.) but masks and gloves would help. Large gatherings that are not family related should not occur, but essential immediate family (to include the in-laws and siblings as family) gatherings should be allowed (e.g., for funerals).

We should not let the fear of economic damage have us rush to opening without appropriate precautions like testing. I do think we should continue to recognize and close the gap between those who have health insurance and pay protection and those who do not. This should be a call to action for the providing a foundation of care to those in need

Do not lift stay at home order until testing and tracking are adequate to contain the virus.

I think it is very important for stores to have special hours for seniors and other high-risk people, and that the number of customers be limited at those times and contagion precautions strictly enforced. Too often, I have had to go into crowded stores in Auburn, and I feel like I am in danger because I am high-risk. The pharmacies at grocery stores and Target are particular problems because they are not open during low-volume times at these stores.

Nothing about the COVID19 threat has changed. We have neither the reduction in infections nor the tools in place (testing, contact-tracing, etc) to "reopen." People are just tired of staying home and in some cases understandably desperate for income. Many more people will die as a result. If the federal response had been on a par with the industrialized world we wouldn't be facing such a severe threat to our health and our economy. It is shameful that states are pitted against each other for resources, and that low-income workers who need income the most will be forced to risk their lives, and the lives of their parents and children, in the coming weeks - because reopening" means they can't get unemployment. There is not much you can do at the County level - a vocal and visible few are intent on disobeying any restrictions, without regard for the general public's health and safety. When weighing health risk, we should think not only of COVID-19 if we reopen, but also of diseases of despair if we don't. There isn't a way forward that avoids all negative outcomes, so we should move forward mitigating both health and economic risk. The only way to do that responsibly is to end the current stay at home order and replace it with phased reopening as quickly and simply as possible. Enforcement can't be the only, or even the main mechanism of adherence to guidance. Communication should include not only rules and regs, but also context that we are not "ready" to reopen in the sense that there will be no negative consequence. Rather, reopening requires shared responsibility of businesses to adjust best practices, and of every person to carefully consider how to best pursue life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness in the midst of an ongoing global pandemic.

I notice that all questions about easing restrictions and allowing gatherings were "with a mask and with 6 foot spacing". I WOULD be willing to do that. My concern is that I see/observe too many people refusing to comply even minimally with these basic requirements RIGHT NOW. No masks, no concern about distancing at Walmart (I WON'T GO THERE for that reason) or even Target. Groups of people at parks... on and on. How will it be enforced? Will you just say, oh sorry we can only ask people to do it, it's not enforceable, like the answer I got when I called the police dept. about a huge Easter party next door? Can it be possible to at least cite/fine people if they refuse to comply? This is way too important to do otherwise.

I think the importance of a healthy diet should be emphasized. There will be a spike in COVID cases and unfortunately a lot of people that were seemingly "healthy" will be exposed as metabolically unhealthy.
